Jack Law saw me on the Baltic Cruise (out of Copenhagen to Russia) and came to almost every show. And of course, Egypt and the pyramids were definitely a highlight of 2009. I'm looking forward to returning to Asia this year, including Shanghai and Tel Aviv.

OM: Any stories of a fav performer you have worked with?

Matt: OMG! There are so many. Patti Lupone was in the audience of my last show in the Med last year and we had so much fun. Of course I had to do "Don't Cry for Me Argentina". After the first chorus, I paused and said, "Wait...someone is singing flat" and looked directly at her. She and the audience cracked up. Of course, I love Chita Rivera. We are good friends and always attend each other's shows. And I

do love listening to stories about Hollywood and the entertainment business over dinner with Alec Mapa and Bruce Villanche.

OM: And lastly, with all the "crusing" you do, do you know how to swim?

Matt: Oh yes. But the funny thing is, because my husband Paul is so fair, we don't swim a lot in Hawaii. I do more swimming in the

Caribbean.
